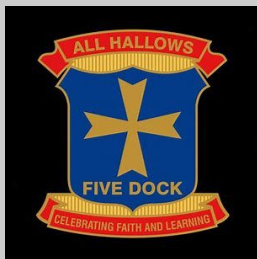

## A Message from Fr Joseph

The Call to Discipleship Go Make Disciples is a call to transform the culture of our parish communities by faithfulness to Jesus' command to "go, make disciples" so that our parishes become outposts of the Great Commission, making disciples who bear fruit for God (Romans 7:4). Jesus is calling us to make the decision to live by His teaching and grace in all aspects of life.

Disciples of Jesus pray with passion. Disciples worship and reach out. Disciples give lavishly time and presence. Disciples love the Church and serve with energy and joy. Disciples hunger to learn more about their faith. Disciples fill every formation class in a parish or diocese. Disciples manifest charisms and discern vocations. They clamour to discern God's call because they long to live it. Disciples evangelise because they have really good news to share. Disciples share their faith with their children.

Today is Laetare ("Rejoice!") Sunday! It is on this Fourth Sunday of Lent that we change liturgical colours to rose in honour of the fact that Easter is drawing near. It is a time to rejoice in the coming celebration of the events of our salvation. Today's second reading summarises the beautiful truth of the Gospel in which we rejoice. While we were "dead in our transgressions [i.e. sins]" and could do nothing to save ourselves, God took action and sent Jesus to die on the cross, rise from the dead, and, therefore, offer us salvation. This salvation is a free gift given to us by God. We do not by any means deserve it. Still, we are called to accept it in faith. God offers us this free gift but He never forces it upon us. We must choose to embrace the gift of salvation and live accordingly. We have been created to live in communion with God. *With God's Blessing for us on this Holy Season of Lent -*

- ★ Zip-lock sandwich bags (large size)

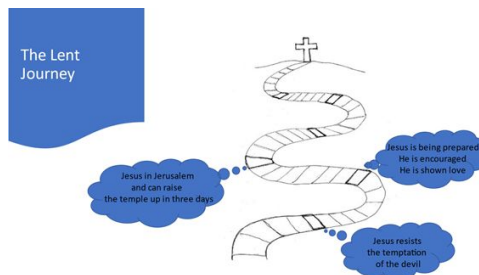

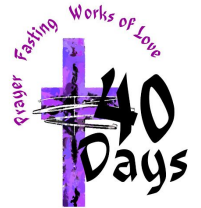
